**Adrs Update (10 June 1962):** 1220 Porter Street, Helena, Arkansas 72342

Immigrated to US at age 4, about 1886

Lived in Middletown, Ohio then moved to Cincinnati, Ohio

Moved to Helena, Arkansas at age 19, about 1901.

**General:** Opened the first Ciener business in Helena, Arkansas about 1908 for the purpose of dry cleaning clothing. Known as "Cieners' the Cleansers."

This business was destroyed by an explosion a few months later. Reopened as a retail men's clothing store, mid-block on Cherry Street, then moved to its final location on the corner of the same block, where it remained until its closure January 15, 1986, prior to the death of Sam Ciener, Jr.
